A 3-days International Congress of Zoology was jointly organized with many other organizations including UNESCO, Pakistan Science Foundation, Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of Pakistan and Pakistan Zoological Society & partners from 2-4 April 2013 at the Convention Centre Islamabad, Pakistan. Over 1500 participants including those from UNESCO, IUCN, WWF participated.



21st ECO Council of Minister (COM) Meeting (24-26 Nov 2013)

•The 21st Meeting of the ECO Council of Ministers was held in Tehran on 26 November 2013. Foreign ministers of Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Iran, the Kyrgyz Republic, Turkey and Adviser to the Prime Minister of Pakistan on National Security and Foreign Affairs, Minister of Economy of Turkmenistan, Deputy Foreign Minister of Kazakhstan and ambassadors of Uzbekistan and Tajikistan represented their respective countries during the meeting. The Council of Ministers' Meeting was preceded by the Senior Officials' Meeting on 24-25 November 2013.



Cooperation with International and Intergovernmental Organizations

*Since June 2013, ECOSF has developed linkages with international science and technology institutions, such as; UNESCO, the British Council, ISTIC Malaysia, European Union, the *La main a la pate* Foundation of France, **COMSATS** and CAB International United Kingdom. The Foundation has been accredited as an Observer/ Stakeholder on Intergovernmental Science and Policy Platform for Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES), Bonn- Germany and participated in the Platform's 2nd Plenary Session held in Antalya Turkey in December 2013. ECOSF has since nominated experts from ECO Region for IPBES task forces of experts on various deliverables.
