ECOSF

ECO Science Foundation (ECOSF) was established on 20 December 2011 in Islamabad- Pakistan as a Specialized Agency of Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO). The 10 Member States of ECOSF include Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Iran, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Pakistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Turkey and Uzbekistan. The mandate of ECOSF is to promote scientific, technological, environmental and



biodiversity research collaboration and other relevant activities among the member states, leading to socioeconomic development in the region. The Foundation has thus established its Science and Technology Fund (S&T Fund) for financing collaborative research projects on competitive basis. In addition, to strengthen the science base of future generations and the region's economy, the Foundation aims to promote Science, Technology, Engineering and

Mathematics (STEM) education at school level, using the Inquiry Based

Science Education (IBSE) approach- La main a la pate. Furthermore, mobilizing and promoting youth engagement in science, technology and education for economic development and peace within the ECO region and beyond, is and remains the priority of ECOSF. Integrating gender perspective in policies, plans and actions directed towards the improvement of life and development of youth in line with UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) will be pursued.



Funding of Collaborative S&T Research Projects in ECO Region

Funding of applied nature research projects aimed at economic development, jointly submitted by the scientists and technologists of ECO Member States is a principal programme of ECO Science Foundation. The joint and collaborative projects are funded through the S&T Fund of ECOSF following a systematic evaluation and funding mechanism as shown in the flow chart. This mechanism/modalities for utilization of S&T Fund has been approved by the Council of Ministers (COM) of ECO.



IBSE - The Inquiry Based Science Education

ECO Science Foundation has initiated IBSE in ECO region and aims to:

- Get more students studying science and mathematics (STEM) at the primary and secondary school levels;
- Prepare students to engage with science ideas and be knowledgeable about the way science and scientists work;
- Raise awareness of opportunities in science and technology-related careers;
- Increase the number of students choosing science and engineering careers to address the shortage
 of science and engineering graduates;
- Improve the quality of science classroom teaching practice;
- Improve science literacy and understanding in the communities;
- Link primary, secondary and tertiary (higher) education, scientific research and Industry, building on the strengths of each sector leading ultimately to knowledge based economic development in the ECO Region.
